T&C's

Submissions

- There are no restrictions based on age, location, or training.
- Artists can submit up to 30 different artworks to be hung, sculpture is also accepted but limited to the space, extra plinths may need to be supplied by the artist. Film is also welcome but you must provide your own tech to display it e.g projector & laptop. We do have a projector screen.
- Must be the owner and creator of the works submitted. The Artist must hold all rights.
- The Artist accepts that any artwork, if exhibited, can be posted on the website.
- The Mount Without will not be liable for any loss or damage to any artworks submitted at any point. Photographs will be taken of the artwork on arrival at the venue and at the departure.
- The Artist accepts that all priced work submitted will be for sale until the end of the exhibition. The Mount Without will take a commission of 25%. This 25% will be taken off the sale price.
- The Mount Without will take payment from the client of the artwork and, once payment is received, The Mount Without will pay the Artist minus the stated commission on the total sale price.
- One artwork to be exhibited is decided, all Artists agree that The Mount Without may promote their work (at no fee) for marketing purposes.

- The image submitted must accurately portray the artwork.

Artwork and Exhibition Requirements

- We accept a wide range of mediums for exhibiting; please get in touch if you are unsure of your submission.
- The performing arts are not accepted besides on the exhibition preview night only - this must be arranged with the venue via email events@themountwithout.co.uk
- Film can only be exhibited during preview night due to the space and other events taking place during the week. The venue has a projection screen the Artist can use but we do not have a projector so this must be taken into consideration. Please email events@themountwithout.co.uk if you are unsure.
- Artworks must be displayed by hanging system, artwork cannot weigh more than 10kg per hanging wire.
- Artworks must not exceed 54 x 38" for the larger column faces or 26 x 35" for the smaller faces. If you do have larger pieces you want to exhibit please contact via email events@themountwithout.co.uk
- If the Artist requires extra plinths, these must be arranged by the Artist.

Final Terms

- Your work should, if possible, should be delivered well wrapped and packaging available to be re-used for collection (if unsold). If you have problems with this, please contact via email events@themountwithout.co.uk. We do not always have packaging available at the venue.
- The Artist must arrange for their artworks to be collected from The Mount Without, at the end of the exhibition, during the dates specified, or they will be liable for a fee of £5 a day to cover storage costs. The collection date will be discussed before exhibiting. If you feel you need an extension on collecting please get in touch with events@themountwithout.co.uk
- If your work has been selected for the exhibition, it will be offered for sale during the exhibition period.
- If work has been selected for the exhibition, these works must continue to be available until the close of the exhibition. We will not be able to allow collection within the exhibition period.
- Artwork such as paintings or hanging works needs to be wired correctly so that it can be hung during the exhibition. Large sculptures will need to be supplied to the Gallery with the correct display equipment. Please contact us for further info.
